

**SHOW SITE** is approximately 17 miles northwest of Delafield via Interstate 94 West, Concord exit #275 for County Road F. Continue north on County Road F for about 5 miles (lots of curves so be careful); turn left onto Elmwood Drive (before railroad tracks); then take the first right onto Cedar Drive. Show site on left at end of the street (white metal building). See special arrow signs on the corner of County Road F, and Elmwood Drive to direct you to the show site.

# TRICK DOG AND CGC TESTING AVAILABLE Saturday —— \$15 per test

### CGC (Canine Good Citizen) will be limited to 10 dogs

Canine Good Citizen is a <u>10-skill test</u> that teaches good manners to dogs and responsible dog ownership to their owners.

- 1. Accepting a friendly stranger Evaluator approaches and pretends to shake hands with handler (hands 6-12" apart). Evaluator does not touch dog.
- 2. Sitting politely for petting Evaluator pets dog; dog must show no shyness or resentment.
- Appearance and grooming Evaluator inspects dog, combs or brushes lightly, examines ears and each front foot.
- **4.** Out for a walk Handler takes dog for a short walk including right turn, left turn, about turn and stop.
- 5. Walking through a crowd Dog and handler walk close to several people; dog may show causal interest but not jump up.
- **6.** Sit and down on cue/Staying in place Handler shows that dog can do both sit and down, then chooses a position, leaves dog and goes to the end of a 20 ft. line, and returns immediately.
- 7. Coming when called With dog still on 20 ft. line from Test 6, handler walks out 10 ft. and calls the dog.
- **8.** Reaction to another dog Two handlers and dogs approach, pretend to shake hands (hands 6-12" apart), exchange pleasantries, then move on.
- 9. Reaction to distractions Distractions are presented; dog may not panic or show aggression.
- 10. Supervised separation Handler goes out of sight for 3-min. Dog is held on a 6-ft. leash by an evaluator.

### Trick Dog Testing: Bring any props that your dog will need to perform the tricks

**AKC Novice Trick Dog (TKN)**- Your dog performs 10 skills from the Novice list. (see link to "Application" below for lists of skills). If a dog has a Canine Good Citizen (CGC) certificate or title on record at AKC, it can do 5 Novice tricks (CGC + 5) to earn the Novice title. See the list of tricks here.

**AKC Intermediate Trick Dog (TKI)** – Your dog must have the Novice title, plus perform 10 Intermediate tricks. See the list of tricks here.

**AKC Advanced Trick Dog (TKA)** – Your dog must have the Intermediate title, plus perform 10 tricks from the Advanced list. See the list of tricks here.

While dogs may begin training for trick and CGC titles as puppies, the earliest an AKC Trick Dog and CGC titles will be awarded by AKC is 4 months.

### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

### OFFERED AT SATURDAY SHOW #2 AND THE SUNDAY SHOW

**NOVICE CLASS:** All ages, who at the time entries close, have not won there (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** All ages, who at the time entries close, have won there (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**BEST MASTER HANDLER:** All ages, who at the time entries close, have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participant return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

# Sanctioned Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition Regulations

### Entry and eligibility requirements include:

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- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.
- Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- Exhibition Only entries may not be changed to be eligible to compete for awards after the close of entries.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

(Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
