Test Hours: 8:30 AM – 4 PM We will have “rolling inspections” and runs.
Events Will Run Concurrently
8:30 AM – Day of Registration, Roll Call, and Inspections: Participants should check in for inspection <u>15 minutes prior to their assigned race time</u> . Inspections and runs will proceed on a rolling basis throughout the event.
9:00 AM – Runs Begin
12:30 – 1:00 PM – Lunch Break
1:30 PM – Runs Resume
Dogs will be staged from “on the line” to 5 th dog in the hole to allow catcher to be ready on the opposite end. It is the responsibility of each entrant to make an effort to be ready when their dog is called. Please follow all instructions of the field crew in order to ensure a smooth and efficient flow. Entrants must provide their own catchers/holders.

Each dog must obtain a run slip for each trial from the secretary table. After obtaining a run slip, head to inspection, and then complete your trial 1 run. Then the dog must return to the secretary table to obtain 2nd run slip and head to inspection again before running in trial 2. We cannot guarantee you will get concurrent runs in the AM.

Course delays may occur due to weather or at the discretion of the Field Chair.

Awards: Each dog qualifying in Fast CAT will be offered a qualifying ribbon. Rosettes will be offered for new titles.

Important Event Information:

Please review the following event requirements and regulations.

No bitches in season may run—per AKC Section 3.2, they are barred from participation and are eligible for a refund only if reported to the Trial Secretary before or during roll call.

We recommend dogs wear a slip lead or flat collar; *choke and pinch collars are not permitted*, and tags must be removed or taped flat. Muzzles are allowed.

Fast CAT is open to dogs **12 months or older** that are AKC registered or enrolled in an AKC-recognized program.

The fairgrounds are not completely fenced. The Fast CAT course will be fenced.

An electric, continuous loop lure machine will be used.

Dogs should be warmed up before running and cooled down after running.

The Field Committee may bar aggressive dogs and alter the course as needed based on field or weather conditions.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Field Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, loss of site, extreme weather conditions, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Each dog requires an individual entry. Dogs may enter only once per event number. Two tests will be offered daily; one entry form may be used per dog for all events. Each test requires a \$25 entry fee for each dog per test for day of entry.

Owners are responsible for the accurateness of the information submitted on their dog's entry form.

Each dog requires two leashes—one for release and one for catching—and **handlers must arrange assistance.**

All dogs run at the owner's sole risk. SRCKCI, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.

No reruns unless equipment failure.

This is an outdoor event so plan accordingly. Bring your own chairs, water, and shade.
Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Field Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Fast CAT

Eligible Breeds & Registry

Females in season may not enter

Open to all dogs at **least 12 months** of age that are:

- Individually registered with the AKC
- Recorded in the FSS program
- Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program with PAL numbers

A dog may enter only once per event (an event is defined by an event number).

If you have a mixed breed dog or dog that is otherwise ineligible for AKC registration you can enroll the dog with the AKC Canine Partners listing. You can enroll your dog at the test site by completing the Canine Partner form included with this premium.

Test, Titles, and Timing

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.

Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

- FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$
- $\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$ (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)

Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

- **BCAT** = 150 points
- **DCAT** = 500 points
- **FCAT** = 1,000 points
- **FCAT#** = Each additional 500 points


Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's and owner's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Field Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. Dogs will be examined for lameness before running.

From east or west of Twin Falls, Idaho on I-84. Take the exit toward US-93 South (Exit #173) and head south towards Twin Falls. Stay in the right lane (cross over the Snake River Canyon). Turn right onto Poleline Road/4100 North. Continue going straight west for about 7.5 miles until 2250 East, turn left (south). The Fairgrounds are 1.5 miles and on the left side. **From south of Twin Falls,** exit US-93 for Filer and turn left (west) onto Hwy 30. Continue to Fair Avenue and turn right. Enter the Fairgrounds at the first open gate.
